Regular school attendance is vital for your childs learning. If a student misses one day of school every two weeks, that equates to missing more than a whole year of school by the age of 16. As a parent/caregiver, it falls to you to ensure your child attends school every day. It is a legal requirement for all children over 6 years of age to attend school.
