

Chickens




As part of Country Life Day, students have the opportunity to order a day old chick, rear it and bring it along for judging on the day. They also need to complete a chicken diary as it grows. (The diary is supplied by school).

Your order form needs to be into the office NO LATER THAN Thursday 4 July, and the chicks need

to be collected from school on Friday 9 August at 2.45pm. (It's a good idea to order more than one chicken in case one dies in the early stages of rearing). Each chicken costs \$6.00 No late orders can be accepted as our supplier cannot source more after they put the order in. (Chicken diaries and rearing information will be given out before you collect your chicks from school)
